Introduction

The Irish Institute of Pensions Management (IIPM) is an educational body which awards professional qualifications for those working in the pensions industry.

The IIPM supports trustees by holding examinations leading to a Certificate of Essential Pensions Knowledge, which provides formal recognition of pensions knowledge and acts as a useful test of trustees' knowledge.

About the Certificate Examination

The Certificate examination covers the Pensions Board recommended trustee training syllabus, using a comprehensive and unique on-line system.

It asks questions on pension subjects including: the role and powers of Trustees, types of pension schemes, the statutory framework, actuarial, investment, administration and disclosure of information.

It is a unique computer based on-line examination. It is very simple to use and, at the end of the test, you will receive automatic confirmation of how you have done.

The flexibility of the system means that you can sit the exam when you want and as often as you want. There are no set times or formal exam halls. You can do it from the comfort of your own office or home, whenever and where ever you like.

How does it work?

When you apply for the examination, you will receive a password and a website address. You simply log onto the website and enter your password.

The test will then commence, and it will take a maximum of 60 minutes to complete. You will be asked 80 multiple choice questions. You select the answer you think is correct and it then progresses to the next question. At the end of the examination you will receive an email advising you on how you have done.

If you have been successful a formal certificate awarding you the Certificate of Essential Pensions Knowledge will be issued to you. If you have been unsuccessful you can resit the examination – when it suits you, and as often as you like.
